This	s report, prepared pursuant to section 20(5) of the Social Services Law (SSL), concerns:
X	A report made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment (SCR) involving the death of a child.
	The death of a child for whom child protective services has an open case.
	The death of a child whose care and custody or custody and guardianship has been transferred to an authorized agency.
	The death of a child for whom the local department of social services has an open preventive service case.

The Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) is mandated by section 20 of the SSL to investigate or cause for the investigation of the cause and circumstances surrounding the death, review such investigation, and prepare and issue a fatality report in regard to the categories of deaths noted above involving a child, except where a local or regional fatality review team issues a report, as authorized by law.

Such report must include: the cause of death; the identification of child protective or other services provided or actions taken regard to such child and child's family; any extraordinary or pertinent information concerning the circumstances of the child's death; whether the child or the child's family received assistance, care or services from the social services district prior to the child's death; any action or further investigation undertaken by OCFS or the social services district since the child's death; and as appropriate, recommendations for local or state administrative or policy changes.

This report contains no information that would identify the deceased child, his or her siblings, the parent, parents, or other persons legally responsible for the child, and any members of the deceased child's household.

By statute, this report will be forwarded to the social services district, chief county executive officer, chairperson of the local legislative body of the county where the child died and the social services district that had legal custody of the child, if different. Notice of the issuance of this report will be sent to the Speaker of the Assembly and the Temporary President of the Senate of the State of New York.

This report may <u>only</u> be disclosed to the public by OCFS pursuant to section 20(5) of the SSL. It may be released by OCFS only after OCFS has determined that such disclosure is not contrary to the best interests of the deceased child's siblings or other children in the household.

OCFS' review included an examination of actions taken by individual caseworkers and supervisors within the social services district and agencies under contract with the social services district. The observations and recommendations contained in this report reflect OCFS' assessment and the performance of these agencies.

#### **Presenting Information**

A report was made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment (SCR) on 08/20/2014, which alleged Inadequate Guardianship and DOA/Fatality against the mother, father and maternal grandparents on behalf of the four-month-old male subject child. This report alleged the subject child was found lying face-down and unresponsive in an adult bed. The adults in the home provided inconsistent accounts as to the location and position of the subject child at the time of the death. The report noted the cause of death to have been Positional Asphyxia thus making the inconsistencies suspicious. First Responders and Police noted the bed the subject child was found on was soft and spongy. A one-year-old female surviving sibling was noted to be in the home.

#### **Executive Summary**

On 10/17/2014, OCDSS made the determination to un-substantiate the allegations listed on the report. The basis for the determination was no credible evidence to support a substantiation of the allegations. The maternal grandparents placed the subject child to sleep on his stomach on a soft surface as the family had done several times in the past. The grandfather observed the subject child to be lying with his face un-obstructed and when he observed the subject child was unresponsive he began chest compressions and the grandmother called 911. The mother and father were not present in the home at the time of the incident. The official cause and manner of death, as determined by the Medical Examiner, was listed as undetermined, as there could be no correlation between the placement of the subject child, the surface in which he was found on, and his demise.

Pediatric records indicated no concerns in regard to the subject child nor the surviving sibling. The Medical Examiner noted no visible signs of trauma, and ruled the cause and manner of death as Undetermined noting the subject child was placed to sleep in prone position on soft bedding. The criminal investigation by the local Law Enforcement remained open at the close of this investigation, pending the final results from the medical examiner. The final autopsy report was not issued until 10/21/2014.

The record did not reflect the positioning of the subject child when found. The mother and father were not present in the home at the time of the incident.
